AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 403.1 TO THE PENAL CODE OF GUAR TO MAKE IT A PRIORY TO GIVE A PAISE REPORT AS TO A BOMB ABOUT TO EXPLODE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PROPIE OF THE THERITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 405.1 is hereby added to the Penal Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 403.1. Disturbing Public by False Reports of Bombs. Every person who wilfully disturbs any other person by a false report that a bomb has been hidden in or about a building, public or otherwise, or in an airplane, or elsewhere, is guilty of a felony, punishable by imprisonment for not less than one (1) year or more than five (5) years, which imprisonment may not be suspended." Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
