



Introduced by G. M. Bamba

AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 403.1 TO THE PENAL CODE  
OF GUAM TO MAKE IT A FELONY TO GIVE A FALSE  
REPORT AS TO A BOMB ABOUT TO EXPLIODE.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 403.1 is hereby added to the Penal Code of  
3 GUAM to read as follows:

4 "Section 403.1. Disturbing Public by False Reports of Bombs.  
5 Every person who wilfully disturbs any other person by a false report  
6 that a bomb has been hidden in or about a building, public or other-  
7 wise, or in an airplane, or elsewhere, is guilty of a felony, punish-  
8 able by imprisonment for not less than one (1) year or more than five  
9 (5) years, which imprisonment may not be suspended."

10 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
