AN ACT

An Act to add Sections 198 and 199 to the Code of Civil Procedure Code of Guam to authorize the Island Court to appoint as deputies of the Island Court Marshal certain employees of the Department of Law and the Department of Finance.

Be it enacted by the People of the Territory of Guam:

Section 1. Section 198 is hereby added to the Code of Civil Procedure of Guar to read as follows:

"Section 198. Appointment of Deputies. The Island Court may appoint employees of the Department of Law and the Department of Finance of the Government of Guam as deputies of the Island Court Marshal. Such appointments shall be for a term of one (1) year unless sooner revoked by the Island Court."

Section 2. Section 199 is hereby added to the Code of Civil Procedure of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 199. Duties: Compensation. The employees of the Department of Law who are appointed as deputies under Section 198 shall exercise their office only in cases wherein the Government of Guam is a party. The employees of the Department of Finance who are appointed as deputies under Section 198 shall exercise their office only in matters concerning the income tax laws and other tax and revenue laws of the territory of Guam. All deputies appointed under Section 198 shall not be entitled to additional

compensation other than the compensation they are receiving as employees of the Government of Guam."

Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.

Approved August 25, 1967.
