AN ACT

An Act to add Section 4120 to the Government Code of Guam to grant authorization for the voluntary allotment of compensation for payment of employee organization dues by Employees of the Government of Guam.

Be it enacted by the People of the Territory of Guam:

Section 1. Section 4120 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 4120. Dues of employees' organizations. Employees, including retired employees of the Government of Guam in addition to any other purposes authorized in this chapter may also authorize deductions to be made from their salaries, wages, or retirement allowances for the payment of dues in any bona fide organization whose membership is comprised, in whole or in part, of employees of the Government of Guam and employees of such organization and which has as one of its objectives improvements in the terms of conditions of employment for the advancement of the welfare of such employees, such deductions to be in accordance with the provisions made by the Personnel Board. The cost of making such deduction shall be a charge against such organization, provided the same shall not exceed 2½% of the amount deducted."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
