

AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 603 TO THE PENAL
CODE OF GUAM MAKING THE LITTERING OF
PUBLIC BEACHES AND PARKS A MISDEMEANOR.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 603 is hereby added to the Penal Code of Guam
3 to read as follows:

4 "Section 603. Littering of public beaches and parks.

5 Every person who wilfully and intentionally litters any public
6 beach or public park by leaving noxious debris, garbage, empty
7 cans, glasses or other unsightly or unsanitary detritus is guilty
8 of a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).

9 In the event any person does more than what is described in the
10 previous sentence and actually uses a public beach or park as a
11 dumping ground is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment
12 for not more than thirty (30) days or by a fine of Two Hundred
13 Dollars (\$200.00), or both such imprisonment and fine."
