AN ACT TO RENUMBER SECTION 44011 OF THE GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM SECTION 44012 AND TO ADD A NEW SECTION
44011 TO SAID GOVERNMENT CODE ESTABLISHING THE METHOD
WHEREBY THE GUAM EMPLOYMENT SERVICE DIVIDES THE
QUOTA OF ALIEN CONTRACT WORKERS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 44011 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby
3 renumbered Section 44012 and a new Section 44011 is hereby added to the
4 Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

5 "Section 44011. Distribution of alien contract worker quota.

6 The Guam Employment Service, in certifying to the U. S. Immigration
7 and Naturalization Service the eligibility of construction contrac-
8 tors to import non-immigrant alien contract labor under the quota
9 given the territory of Guam pursuant to its rehabilitation program,
10 shall divide the quota among all of the licensed construction con-
11 tractors in the territory of Guam, without regard to the date their
12 licenses were obtained. In the event such a construction contractor
13 does not wish to use his share of the quota so allocated to him,
14 then the Guam Employment Service shall reallocate such unused
15 portion of the quota to all such contractors who desire to import
16 such alien contract workers. It is the intent of this Section to
17 assure all licensed construction contractors in the territory of Guam
18 that each will be given a fair and equitable share of that quota of
19 alien contract workers established for the territory of Guam for
20 rehabilitation purposes."

21 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
