AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 11411 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO PROVIDE THAT MEDICAL EXPENSES INCURRED BY PUPILS INJURED DURING SCHOOL HOURS IN ANY OF THE SCHOOLS OF GUAM BE PAID BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 11411 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam to
3 read as follows:

4 "Section 11411. Free medical expenses for injured pupils. If a pupil
5 of any of the public or private schools of the territory is injured during
6 school hours on school property, while traveling directly between his home
7 and school, while participating in or attending any regularly approved,
8 supervised activity of the school, or while traveling to and from such activity
9 as a member of a group which is under the school's supervision, all medical
10 expenses incurred as a result of such injury shall be borne by the Board, except
11 that if the pupil is covered by health or accident insurance as will reimburse
12 him or his parents or guardians for such medical expenses in whole or in part,
13 then the Board shall bear only those expenses, if any, in excess of the
14 insurance payments made or to be made by the pupil's insurance carrier on
15 account of such injury. In providing for such payments, the Board is authorized
16 to obtain insurance covering the same, which insurance coverage may be broadened
17 to include compensation for accidental loss of life, sight or limbs."

18 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
