AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTION 11837 OF THE GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM AND TO ADD A NEW SECTION 11837 TO
GRANT FOUR YEARS OF FREE TUITION AT THE COLLEGE
OF GUAM TO VETERANS OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE
UNITED STATES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 11837 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby
3 repealed and a new Section 11837 is hereby added to said Government
4 Code to read as follows:

5 "Section 11837. Fees and Tuition: Exceptions. Fees
6 and rates of tuition shall be fixed by the Board of Regents,
7 with the following exceptions:

8 (1) Members of the Armed Forces of the United States
9 on active duty and residents of Guam not otherwise eligible
10 for waiver of tuition shall be charged tuition rates 50% of
11 those charged non-residents of Guam;

12 (2) Residents of Guam who have resided on Guam at
13 least two years prior to admission will be charged no
14 tuition for attendance during their freshman and sophomore
15 years at the college; and

16 (3) Veterans of the Armed Forces of the United States,
17 who shall have resided in Guam at least two years prior to
18 their induction into the Armed Forces, and who were dis-
19 charged therefrom under conditions other than dishonorable,
20 will be charged no tuition for attendance during their
21 freshman, sophomore, junior, and senior years at the
22 college."

23 Section 2. This Act shall take effect July 1, 1968.

24 Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
