AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49007 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO PROVIDE THAT NO ACTION MAY BE TAKEN TO ENFORCE HOSPITAL CHARGES UNLESS RULES ON ABATHAMNTS THEREOF HAVE BEEN PROMULGATED, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 49007 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 49007. Fees. The Administrator is authorized to establish a schedule of fees to be charged for care and services at or by the hospital, subject to the approval of the Board. Ho action may be taken by the Administrator or by the government of Guam to enforce payment of such fees unless the rules, and policies for abatements and discounts from such fees as authorized by the provisions of Section 49008 of this title, have been duly and regularly adopted and promulgated pursuant to the requirements of the Administrative Adjudication Law. In addition, no court of Guam may give judgment for the government of Guam in an action to collect such fees unless the court shall have been furnished a written finding under eath by the Administrator that the defendant in such collection action had the financial ability to pay such fee, as determined by the rules and policies promulgated pursuant to said Section 49008, at the time the fee was incurred."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
