AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 9620.12 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO AUTHORIZE THE CONFINEMENT OR DESTRUCTION OF NON-RABID DOGS WHO HAVE BITTEN PERSONS ONLY IF SUCH DOGS WERE RUNNING AT LARGE AT THE TIME OF BITING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 9620.12 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 9620.12. Vicious Dogs. Any dog showing no other apparent signs of disease but which, while running at large, has bitten a person or persons two or more times may be declared to be a vicious dog and ordered confined or destroyed by the Director." Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
