

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 9620.12 OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO AUTHORIZE
THE CONFINEMENT OR DESTRUCTION OF NON-
RABID DOGS WHO HAVE BITTEN PERSONS ONLY
IF SUCH DOGS WERE RUNNING AT LARGE AT
THE TIME OF BITING.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 9620.12 of the Government Code of Guam
3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 9620.12. Vicious Dogs. Any dog showing no other
5 apparent signs of disease but which, while running at large, has
6 bitten a person or persons two or more times may be declared to
7 be a vicious dog and ordered confined or destroyed by the Director."

8 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
