AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 13200, CHAPTER 3, TITLE
XIV, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO IN-
CREASING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE TERRITORIAL
PLANNING COMMISSION.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 13200 of the Government Code of Guam, is
3 hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 13200. Territorial Planning Commission. There
5 is within the government of Guam the 'Territorial Planning
6 Commission.' The Commission shall be composed of seven (7)
7 members to be appointed by the Governor by and with the
8 advice and consent of the Legislature for a period of five
9 (5) years; provided, however, that, of the two members first
10 appointed, one (1) shall serve for a term of one (1) year,
11 two (2) shall serve for terms of three (3) years each, and
12 the remaining two (2) shall serve for terms of five (5)
13 years each, as designated by the Governor. The Governor
14 shall appoint a member of the Commission to serve as
15 Chairman."
