



AN ACT TO RENUMBER SECTION 19575 OF THE GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM AND TO ENACT A NEW SECTION 19575.02
TO SECTION 19575.01 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM,
RELATIVE TO LIQUID FUEL TAX.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 19575 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby
3 renumbered 19575.01.

4 Section 2. A new Section 19575.02 is hereby added to the Government
5 Code of Guam to read as follows:

6 "Section 19575.02. Exemption for Charters. Liquid fuel
7 purchased for aviation purposes and used solely in aircraft under
8 charter to the United States Department of Defense shall be excluded
9 from the computation of the liquid fuel tax by the distributor
10 selling liquid fuel for such purposes."
