AN ACT TO RENUMBER SECTION 19575 OF THE COVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM AND TO ENACT A NEW SECTION 19575.02 TO SECTION 19575.01 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO LIQUID FUEL TAX.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 19575 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby renumbered 19575.01.

Section 2. A new Section 19575.02 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 19575.02. Exemption for Charters. Liquid fuel purchased for aviation purposes and used solely in aircraft under charter to the United States Department of Defense shall be excluded from the computation of the liquid fuel tax by the distributor selling liquid fuel for such purposes."
