AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 26203 TO THE GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM TO NAME THE PARK IN THE MUNICIPALITY
OF PITI THE "PEDRO C. SANTOS MEMORIAL PARK."

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 26203 is hereby added to the Government Code
3 of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 26203. Pedro C. Santos Memorial Park. The public
5 park in the Municipality of Piti bounded on the south by Hoover
6 Park and delineated in Public Works Drawing No. E4-62P-582, is
7 hereby named the 'Pedro C. Santos Memorial Park' in honor of and
8 as a lasting memorial to the late Pedro C. Santos, a member of the
9 Guam Legislature who unselfishly devoted much of his public ser-
10 vice to the betterment of the Municipality of Piti."

11 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
