AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION (b) OF SECTION 37006, SUBSECTIONS (a) AND (e) OF SECTION 37009 AND SUBSECTION (m) OF SECTION 37014 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO INCREASE COMPENSATION FOR DISABILITY AND DEATH UNDER THE NORMEN'S COMPENSATION ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

- Section 1. Subsection (b) of Section 37006, Government Code of Guam, is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - "(b) Compensation for disability shall not exceed fifty—six dollars (\$56) per week and compensation for total disability shall not be less than twenty—eight dollars (\$28) per week: Provided that if the employee's average weekly wages, as computed under Section 37010 are less than twenty—eight dollars (\$28) per week, he shall receive as compensation for total disability his average weekly wages."
- Section 2. Subsections (a) and (e) of Section 37009 of the Government Code of Guam are hereby amended to read as follows:
 - "(a) Reasonable funeral expenses not exceeding six hundred dollars (\$600).
 - (e) In computing death benefits the average weekly wages of the deceased shall be considered to have been not more than eighty—four dollars (\$84.00) nor less than thirty—six dollars (\$36.00) but the total weekly compensation shall not exceed the weekly wages of the deceased."
- Section 3. Subsection (m) of Section 37014 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - "(m) The total compensation payable under this title for injuries not resulting in death shall in no event exceed the sum of twenty thousand

dollars (320,000). In cases of disability compensable under paragraph (21) of Subsection (c) of Section 37008 the total compensation for such disability, and for any temporary partial disability sustained in addition therein, shall not exceed in the aggregate the sum of twenty thousand dollars (520,000).

Section 4. This Act shall take effect July 1, 1968. Section 5. This Act is an urgency measure.
