



AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION (b) OF SECTION 37006,
SUBSECTIONS (a) AND (e) OF SECTION 37009 AND
SUBSECTION (m) OF SECTION 37014 OF THE GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM TO INCREASE COMPENSATION FOR DISABILITY
AND DEATH UNDER THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION ACT.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Subsection (b) of Section 37006, Government Code of Guam, is
3 hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "(b) Compensation for disability shall not exceed fifty-six dollars
5 (\$56) per week and compensation for total disability shall not be less than
6 twenty-eight dollars (\$28) per week: Provided that if the employee's average
7 weekly wages, as computed under Section 37010 are less than twenty-eight
8 dollars (\$28) per week, he shall receive as compensation for total disability
9 his average weekly wages."

10 Section 2. Subsections (a) and (e) of Section 37009 of the Government Code
11 of Guam are hereby amended to read as follows:

12 "(a) Reasonable funeral expenses not exceeding six hundred dollars (\$600).

13 (e) In computing death benefits the average weekly wages of the
14 deceased shall be considered to have been not more than eighty-four dollars
15 (\$84.00) nor less than thirty-six dollars (\$36.00) but the total weekly
16 compensation shall not exceed the weekly wages of the deceased."

17 Section 3. Subsection (m) of Section 37014 of the Government Code of Guam is
18 hereby amended to read as follows:

19 "(m) The total compensation payable under this title for injuries
20 not resulting in death shall in no event exceed the sum of twenty thousand

RELATIVE TO DISABILITY COMPENSATION

1 dollars (\$20,000). In cases of disability compensable under paragraph
2 (21) of Subsection (c) of Section 37008 the total compensation for such
3 disability, and for any temporary partial disability sustained in addition
4 therein, shall not exceed in the aggregate the ~~sum~~ of twenty thousand
5 dollars (\$20,000).

6 Section 4. This Act shall take effect July 1, 1968.

7 Section 5. This Act is an urgency measure.
