

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
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 53554 AND 53557 OF CHAPTER
1, TITLE LIV, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO
THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE GUAM ECONOMIC DEVELOP-
MENT AUTHORITY.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 53554 of Chapter 1, Title LIV, Government
3 Code of Guam, is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 53554. Board of Directors. All functions and powers
5 of the Corporation shall be vested in and be exercised by and under
6 the direction of a Board of Directors hereinafter referred to as the
7 Board, [composed of seven (7) members, appointed by the Governor of
8 Guam with the advice and consent of the Guam Legislature. Members
9 of the Board shall serve for a term of four (4) years. The
10 Governor shall appoint a member of the Board to serve as Chairman.]"

11 Section 2. Section 53557, Chapter 1, Title LIV, Government Code of
12 Guam, is hereby amended to read as follows:

13 "Section 53557. Qualifications for Directors. The Board
14 members to be appointed by the Governor of Guam as above stated
15 shall be U. S. citizens, selected from individuals who have resided
16 in Guam at least six (6) continuous months immediately preceding
17 their appointments, who have demonstrated their ability and their
18 attachment to public interest, and selected to provide diversified
19 experience among Board members. The Administrator shall be a U. S.
20 citizen, appointed without regard to the provisions of Personnel
21 Laws and who possesses qualities, knowledge, experience and diver-
22 sified ability necessary to pursue effectively the program of the
23 Corporation, regardless of the length of his previous residence
24 on Guam."

25 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
