


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 13902, GOVERNMENT CODE
OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF THE GUAM HOUSING AND URBAN RENEWAL AUTHORITY.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Subsection (b) of Section 13902, Government Code of Guam,
3 is amended to read as follows:

4 "(b) The powers, rights, privileges, functions and duties of
5 the Authority shall be vested in seven commissioners, not more than
6 three of whom shall be at any time a salaried official or employee
7 of the government of Guam or of the United States."

8 Section 2. Subsection (h) of Section 13902, Government Code of Guam,
9 is amended to read as follows:

10 "(h) Four commissioners shall constitute a quorum of the Board
11 of Commissioners of the Authority for the purpose of conducting the
12 business of the Authority and exercising its powers, and for all other
13 purposes. A vote of the majority of commissioners present at any
14 meeting of the Board shall prevail."

15 Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
