AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 7001 OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO PROVIDE
THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF LAW OF THE
GOVERNMENT OF GUAM MAY NOT DELEGATE
ANY OF ITS RESPONSIBILITY OVER
LITIGATION INVOLVING THE GOVERNMENT
OF GUAM TO ANY ATTORNEY IN PRIVATE
PRACTICE.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 7001 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby
3 amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 7001. Department of Law, cognizance.

5 The Department of Law shall have cognizance of all
6 legal matters in which the government of Guam is in
7 anywise interested. Neither the Attorney General
8 nor the Island Attorney shall delegate to any
9 attorney in private practice in Guam the collection
10 of any account or other obligation owing to the
11 government of Guam, or to say agency or instrumentality
12 thereof. It shall have cognizance of all matters
13 pertaining to public prosecution. For this purpose
14 the Island Attorney, deputy Island Attorneys and
15 all employees of the Island Attorney's office shall
16 form the prosecution division of the Department of
17 Law and are placed under the jurisdiction of the
18 Attorney General."

19 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
