AH ACT TO ADD SECTION 1102.1 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAN TO MAKE PUBLIC HEARINGS ON ALL BILLS MANDATORY.

BE IT EMACTED BY THE PROPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAL:

Section 1. Section 1102.1 is hereby added to the Government

Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 1102.1. Public Hearings Handatory. No bill may
be passed by the Legislature unless it has received a public
hearing, except that when the presiding officer of the Legislature
certifies that emergency conditions exist, inwolving danger to the
public health or safety, the requirement for a public hearing
may be waived and in the event the bill is identical to a bill
introduced earlier which latter bill received a public hearing
them a public hearing for the identical bill may be waived."
