AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 1102.1 TO THE GOVERNMENT  
CODE OF GUAM TO MAKE PUBLIC HEARINGS ON ALL  
BILLS MANDATORY.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 1102.1 is hereby added to the Government

3 Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 1102.1. Public Hearings Mandatory. No bill may  
5 be passed by the Legislature unless it has received a public  
6 hearing, except that when the presiding officer of the Legislature  
7 certifies that emergency conditions exist, involving danger to the  
8 public health or safety, the requirement for a public hearing  
9 may be waived and in the event the bill is identical to a bill  
10 introduced earlier which latter bill received a public hearing  
11 then a public hearing for the identical bill may be waived."
