AN ACT TO ENACT A NEW CHAPTER 8 TO TITLE  
V, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO  
EMPLOYEE SAFETY PROGRAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. A new Chapter 8 is hereby added to Title V, Government  
3 Code of Guam, to read as follows:

4 "CHAPTER 8

5 Employee Safety

6 Section 4450. Program. The Governor of Guam shall establish  
7 within the government of Guam a safety program for employees, and in  
8 furtherance thereof, he shall cause to be made such studies and inves-  
9 tigations as may be necessary to determine the safety conditions within  
10 the government of Guam. In carrying out the provisions of this Chapter,  
11 the Governor of Guam may enter upon any premises administered by any  
12 department, agency or public corporation of the government of Guam.  
13 A report from time to time shall be made as to safety conditions in the  
14 government of Guam, together with recommendations for preventing injuries,  
15 which report shall be circulated among the various governmental agencies  
16 for implementation."

17 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
