AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 4120 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE
OF GUAM RELATIVE TO THE VOLUNTARY ALLOTMENT OF
COMPENSATION FOR PAYMENTS OF EMPLOYEE ORGANIZATION
DUES BY EMPLOYERS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 4120 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby
3 amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 4120. Dues of employees' organizations.

5 Employees, including retired employees, of the government of Guam
6 in addition to any other purposes authorized in this chapter may
7 also authorize deductions to be made from their salaries, wages,
8 or retirement allowances for the payment of dues in any bona fide
9 organization whose membership is comprised, in whole or in part,
10 of employees of the government of Guam and employees of such organi-
11 zation and which has as one of its objectives improvements in the
12 terms of conditions of employment for the advancement of the welfare
13 of such employees. The cost of making such deduction shall be a
14 charge against such organization, provided the same shall not exceed
15 $2\frac{1}{2}\%$ of the amount deducted."

16 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 11411 OF CHAPTER 5, TITLE
XII, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO FREE
PAYMENT OF MEDICAL EXPENSES OF PUPILS INJURED IN
THE SCHOOLS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 11411 of Chapter 5, Title XII, Government Code of Guam,
3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 11411. Free medical expenses for injured pupils. If a
5 pupil of any of the public or private schools of the territory is injured
6 during school hours on school property, while traveling directly between
7 his home and school in public school buses, while participating in or
8 attending any regularly approved, supervised activity of the school during
9 school hours or, after school hours, if the school activity is under direct
10 school supervision, or while traveling in public school buses to and from
11 such school activity as a member of a group which is under the school's
12 supervision, all medical expenses incurred as a result of such injury shall
13 be borne by the Board, except that if the pupil is covered by health or
14 accident insurance as will reimburse him or his parents or guardians for
15 such medical expenses in whole or in part, then the Board shall bear only
16 those expenses, if any, in excess of the insurance payments made or to be
17 made by the pupil's insurance carrier on account of such injury. In
18 providing for such payments, the Board is authorized to obtain insurance
19 covering the same, which insurance coverage may be broadened to include
20 compensation for accidental loss of life, sight or limbs."

21 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
