AN ACT ADDING A NEW SUBCHAPTER H TO CHAPTER 9,  
TITLE XII, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM AUTHORIZING  
THE GOVERNOR TO AWARD TWO ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIPS  
TO THE COLLEGE OF GUAM TO BONA FIDE RESIDENTS  
OF TERRITORIES WHICH ARE MEMBERS OF THE SOUTH  
PACIFIC COMMISSION.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. New Subchapter H is hereby added to Chapter 9, Title XII  
3 of the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "SUBCHAPTER H

5 Residents of Other Territories

6 Section 11823. Scholarships for Other Territories. The Governor  
7 of Guam is hereby authorized to award two annual scholarships to bona fide  
8 residents of insular territories which are within the jurisdiction of the  
9 South Pacific Commission and whose residents are not otherwise eligible for  
10 scholarships to the College of Guam. These scholarships shall be to attend  
11 a full-time course of study at the College of Guam.

12 Section 11824. Same: Amount thereof. The scholarship shall include  
13 tuition, books, and room and board and shall be for such period of time as  
14 required to complete the program which the recipient is pursuing.

15 Section 11825. Same: Conditions. To receive the scholarship, and  
16 to keep it, the recipient must meet at all times all the academic requirements  
17 of the College of Guam and must abide with all the regulations governing  
18 student conduct thereat.

19 Section 11826. Same: Selection. Selection shall be made on the  
20 basis of scholarship, attitude, and desire. As a condition for the award,  
21 a recipient must agree to return to his native island for at least one year  
22 immediately following completion of his studies."

23 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
