AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF ARANDONED VEHICLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the Abandoned Vehicle Fund established by Public Law 9-42 the sum of Twenty-nine Thousand Dollars (\$29,000) to be used during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 for the purpose of removing and disposing of all abandoned vehicles found upon public and private property in Guam; provided, however, that none of the monies hereby appropriated may be expended on any commitments made in connection with such removal and disposition prior to the effective date of this Act.

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
