AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE  
REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF ABANDONED  
VEHICLES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the Abandoned  
3 Vehicle Fund established by Public Law 9-42 the sum of Twenty-nine  
4 Thousand Dollars (\$29,000) to be used during the fiscal year ending  
5 June 30, 1968 for the purpose of removing and disposing of all  
6 abandoned vehicles found upon public and private property in Guam;  
7 provided, however, that none of the monies hereby appropriated may  
8 be expended on any commitments made in connection with such removal  
9 and disposition prior to the effective date of this Act.

10 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
