



AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 15103 OF THE GOVERNMENT  
CODE OF GUAM TO PROVIDE GUAM'S WASHINGTON REPRESENTATIVE AN ALLOWANCE FOR TRANSPORTATION OF HIS  
HOUSEHOLD AND PERSONAL EFFECTS TO AND FROM  
WASHINGTON, D. C.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 15103 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby  
3 amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 15103. Same: compensation and expenses. The  
5 Washington representative shall be paid an annual salary of  
6 Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) and in addition  
7 thereto shall be allowed an annual budget for the purposes  
8 of providing round trip transportation from Guam to  
9 Washington, D. C., for himself and dependents once each  
10 year and to provide for necessary expenses of office rental  
11 and such clerical and technical assistance as he may deem  
12 in the public interest. In addition, the Washington repre-  
13 sentative shall be entitled to an allowance to provide for  
14 transportation at government of Guam expense of his household  
15 and personal effects, including his automobile, from Guam to  
16 Washington, D. C., and upon the termination of his term of  
17 office, for whatever cause, to transport such household and  
18 personal effects, including his automobile, back to Guam."
