AN ACT TO AMEND SUBPARAGRAPH (b) OF SECTION 11876
OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO INCREASE THE MONTHLY
ALLOWANCES GIVEN TEACHER TRAINEES AT THE COLLEGE OF GUAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Subparagraph (b) of Section 11876 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(b) Unmarried Trainees shall receive a monthly allowance in the amount of Seventy-Five Dollars (\$75) during the first year, One Hundred Dollars (\$100) during the second year, One Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars (\$125) during the third year, and One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150) during the fourth year of the program. Married trainees shall receive a monthly allowance of One Hundred Dollars (\$100) during the first year, One Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars (\$125) during the second year, One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150) during the third year, and One Hundred Seventy-Five Dollars (\$175) during the fourth year of the program. Registration, tuition and other fees normally assessed shall not be charged, and a credit allowance in an amount not to exceed Seventy-Five Dollars (\$75) shall be allowed for each six months to cover the cost of textbooks and supplies."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
