


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

Bill No. 362

Introduced by J. B. Torres

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 201 OF THE GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM TO PROVIDE THAT IF A HOLIDAY FALLS
UPON A SATURDAY, THE PREVIOUS FRIDAY SHALL BE
A HOLIDAY.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 201 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby
3 amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 201. Same. If any of the holidays enumerated
5 in Section 200, (b) through (1), inclusive, falls upon a Sunday,
6 the following Monday is a holiday, and if any of such holidays
7 falls upon a Saturday, the preceding Friday is a holiday."

8 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
