AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR NECESSARY
CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. The following sums are hereby appropriated from any
available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund for

Section 4. Appropriations made by Section 3 of this Act shall be effective July 1, 1968 and shall be available for all expenses incident to the purpose for which made. Every appropriation herein shall continue in full force and effect and shall be available until expended for the project for which made or until the project is completed.

Section 5. This Act is an urgency measure.
