

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 9130 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE  
OF GUAM RELATIVE TO THE QUALIFICATION AND PAY RANGE  
OF A PUBLIC DEFENDER.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 9130 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby  
3 amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 9130. Public Defender. There is hereby established  
5 within the Division of Public Welfare in the Department of Public  
6 Health and Welfare, the office of the Public Defender of Guam,  
7 which shall be filled by an attorney of not less than six (6) year's  
8 experience in the general practice of law, either government or  
9 private, including trial and appellate work, who shall be appointed  
10 by the Governor and who shall be a member of the Classified Service  
11 of the government of Guam with pay range 35. For purposes of  
12 performing his official duties, the Public Defender may practice  
13 before the courts of Guam on the same basis as other government  
14 attorneys under Section 28002.2, Government Code of Guam."

15 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
