AN ACT TO REPEAL AND REENACT SECTION 573 OF
THE CODE OF CIVIL PROCEDURE OF THE TERRITORY
OF GUAM AUTHORIZING THE DEPOSIT OF COURT FUNDS
IN LOCAL BANKS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 573 of the Code of Civil Procedure of the
3 territory of Guam is hereby repealed and a new Section 573 is hereby
4 enacted to read as follows:

5 "Section 573. Clerk to Deposit Money Received.

6 Whenever money is paid into or deposited in court to be held in
7 custody or trust for or on behalf of a person other than the
8 government of Guam, the same shall be delivered to the clerk of
9 the court in person. He thereupon must deposit it with a licensed
10 bank in Guam in a special trust account in the name of the Court
11 which shall be drawn upon only on order of the court. All money
12 received to which the government of Guam is entitled, such as
13 fines, costs, filing fees, and the like shall be deposited with
14 the treasurer of the government of Guam."

15 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
