


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

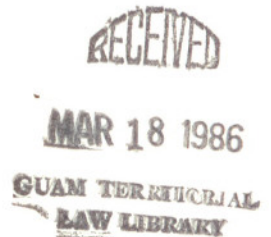

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE ADVANCE OF MONIES  
FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE SINAJANA  
URBAN RENEWAL PROJECT.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby authorized to be advanced from the  
3 General Fund up to Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000) during the  
4 fiscal year ending June 30, 1968, to the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal  
5 Authority as the initial contribution of the government of Guam in the  
6 execution of the urban renewal plan for Sinajana and a portion of Agana  
7 Heights, (Urban Renewal Project No. Guam R-2a). All funds advanced  
8 hereunder shall be repaid to the General Fund by the Authority upon its  
9 receipt of funds therefor under the Guam Rehabilitation Act.

10 Section 2. There is hereby authorized to be advanced from the General  
11 Fund up to Three Hundred Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$312,000.00) during the  
12 fiscal year ending June 30, 1968, to the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal  
13 Authority for the acquisition and development of lands under the  
14 government of Guam Sinajana Village Development-Non Title I Subdivision  
15 to be used as a relocation resource. All funds advanced hereunder shall  
16 be repaid to the General Fund by the Authority upon its receipt of  
17 funds therefor under the Guam Rehabilitation Act.

18 Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
