AN ACT TO ADD SUBSECTION .1012 TO SECTION
19543 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM,
RELATIVE TO EXEMPTION FROM THE GROSS
RECEIPTS TAX.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Subsection .1012 is hereby added to Section 19543
3 of the Government Code of Guam, to read as follows:

4 ".1012. All of the gross proceeds received by
5 contractors for the construction of residential
6 buildings developed, owned, and operated by non-profit
7 corporations or associations, which construction is
8 pursuant to a program approved by the Secretary of
9 Housing and Urban Development pursuant to Section
10 221(d)(5) of the Housing Act, as amended."

11 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
