



AN ACT AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION SECTION
OF PUBLIC LAW 9-71, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:*

Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law 9-71 is hereby amended to
read as follows:
