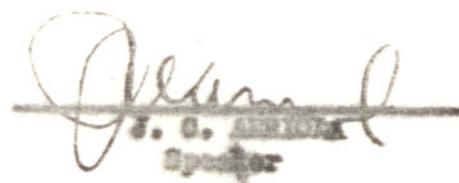

AN ACT AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION SECTION  
OF PUBLIC LAW 9-71, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law 9-71 is hereby amended to  
read as follows:

"Section 1. The following sums are hereby appropriated from  
any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General  
Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968, for the purposes
