AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SECTION 6119 TO CHAPTER 2, TITLE VII, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO ACCEPTANCE AND USE OF CHARITABLE DONATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new Section 6119 is hereby added to Chapter 2, Title VII, Government Code of Guam, to read as follows:

"Section 6119. Charitable donations: use. The Governor is authorized to accept monetary donations, from any individual or organization, which shall be deposited in a separate fund by the Treasurer of Guam. Such donations shall, upon authorization by the Governor, be used and expended in accordance with the terms and conditions upon which they are made. Nothing herein shall be construed to prevent the Governor on behalf of the government of Guam from accepting donations of property from any individual or organization."
