AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SUBSECTION (e) TO SECTION 17151, CHAPTER 4, TITIE XVIII, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO REMOVING THE HEIGHT LIMITATION ON HOTELS.

HE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new Subsection (e) is hereby added to Section 17151, Chapter 4, Title XVIII, Government Code of Guam, to read as follows:

"(e) Hotels, provided, that for every foot in elevation exceeding the standard limitation, two feet shall be added to each of the required yard depths and widths; and provided, further, that the height limit for any such hotel shall be six stories (the six stories shall not exceed a height of seventy-five (75) feet)."
