



AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SUBSECTION (e) TO SECTION  
17151, CHAPTER 4, TITLE XVIII, GOVERNMENT CODE  
OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO REMOVING THE HEIGHT  
LIMITATION ON HOTELS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. A new Subsection (e) is hereby added to Section 17151,  
3 Chapter 4, Title XVIII, Government Code of Guam, to read as follows:

4 "(e) Hotels, provided, that for every foot in elevation  
5 exceeding the standard limitation, two feet shall be added  
6 to each of the required yard depths and widths; and provided,  
7 further, that the height limit for any such hotel shall be  
8 six stories (the six stories shall not exceed a height of  
9 seventy-five (75) feet)."
