AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 47002, CHAPTER 1, TITLE XLIII, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO MEMBERSHIP OF THE BOARD OF ENGINEERING AND ARCHITECTURAL EXAMINERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 47002 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 47002. Board of Engineering and Architectural Examiners. There is within the government of Guam a Board of Engineering and Architectural Examiners. The Board shall consist of the Director of Public Works, ex officio, who shall be chairman, and four additional members appointed by the Governor. The appointed members shall serve for terms of three years. One of the appointed members shall be a professional architect, one of the appointed members shall be a professional engineer, one shall be either a professional engineer or professional architect, and one shall be a land surveyor. Each appointed member shall have at least ten years active experience and be of recognized good standing in his profession, be at least thirty years of age, a United States citizen and a registered professional engineer, land surveyor or architect under this Title; provided, that the Governor may appoint to the Board, persons exempted under Item (a) of Section 47028 of this Title if they are registered in one of the states or territories of the United States, the Canal Zone or Puerto Rico, and in that event, such persons need not be registered under this Title."
