AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE XLIII, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO REQUIREMENTS AND STANDARDS UNDER THE PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS, ARCHITECTS AND LAND SURVEYORS LAW.

HE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Item (3) of Subsection (a), Section 47013, Government Code of Guam, is hereby repealed and a new Item (3) is hereby added to Subsection (a) of Section 47013, Government Code of Guam, to read as follows:

- "(3) A specific record of at least twenty years of lawful practice in engineering work, of which at least ten years have been in responsible charge of important engineering work, of a grade and character which indicates to the Board that the applicant may be competent to practice engineering and passing an oral, written or oral and written examination as prescribed by the Board."

 Section 2. Item (3) of Subsection (c), Section 47013, Government

 Code of Guam, is hereby repealed and a new Item (3) is hereby addedo:
 to Subsection (c) of Section 47013, Government Code of Guam, to read as follows:
- "(3) A specific record of at least twenty years of lawful practice in architectural work of which at least ten years have been in responsible charge of important architectural work, of a grade and character which indicates to the Board that the applicant may be competent to practice architecture and passing an oral, written or oral and written examination as prescribed by the Board." Section 3. Item (3) of Subsection (d), Section 47013, Government Code of Guam, is hereby repealed.
