AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 640b TO THE PENAL CODE OF GUAM TO PROHIBIT REFUSAL TO RELINQUISH PARTY LINES IN EMERGENCIES AND TO PROHIBIT SECURING PARTY LINES BY FALSELY CLAIMING EMERGENCIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 640b is hereby added to the Penal Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 640b. Refusal to Relinquish Party Line; Fraudulently Obtaining of Party Line. Penalty. Every person who shall refuse to immediately relinquish a multi-party telephone line when informed that such party line is needed for an emergency call either to a fire department, or police department or for medical aid or ambulance services, and every person who shall secure the use of such a party line by falsely stating that such line is needed for an emergency call, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not exceeding \$500 or by imprisonment not exceeding one year, or by both such fine and imprisonment."
