AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 3009 TO THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO PROVIDE
THAT NO GOVERNMENT AGENCY MAY PUBLISH
A NEWSPAPER.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 3009 is hereby added to the

3 Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 3009. Newspaper publication prohibited.

5 Neither the Governor, nor any other officer, or
6 agency of the government of Guam may spend public
7 funds for the purpose of publishing a newspaper to
8 be circulated among the employees of the government
9 of Guam unless such newspaper is published in the
10 format of a newsletter whose page dimensions are
11 no greater than 8½ inches by 11 inches, and which
12 is confined entirely to news concerning the office
13 or agency publishing such newsletter. The intent
14 of this section is to prohibit the use of public
15 monies to publish newspapers in direct competition
16 with privately-owned newspapers in the territory
17 of Guam."
