

Committed on Rules, by request of the Governor in accordance with Section 6 (b) of the Organic Act of Guam.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 441 OF ARTICLE II, CHAPTER IV, DIVISION III OF THE PROBATE CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO SERVICE OF NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR LETTERS OF ADMINISTRATION.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 441 of the Probate Code of Guam is hereby  
3 amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 441. Procedure before hearing. The clerk shall  
5 set the petition for hearing by the court and give notice there-  
6 of by causing a notice to be posted at the courthouse in Agana,  
7 giving the name of the decedent, the name of the applicant,  
8 and the time at which the application will be heard. Such  
9 notice must be given at least 10 days before the hearing. The  
10 clerk shall cause similar notice to be mailed, postage prepaid,  
11 to the heirs of the decedent named in the petition, at least  
12 10 days before the hearing, addressed to them at their res-  
13 pective post-office addresses, as set forth in the petition.  
14 Any notice required by this Section may, in lieu of mailing,  
15 be served personally upon the heirs of the decedent named  
16 in the petition."

17 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
