AN ACT AMENDING SECTION 17350 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO

GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF AUTOMOBILE PARKING SPACE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:: Section 1. Section 17350 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 17350. Automobile Parking Space. Off-street automobile parking space shall be provided as follows:

(a) For dwellings, at least one automobile parking spacefor each dwelling unit;

(b) For hotels, at least one automobile parking space for each four guest rooms;

(c) For places of assembly with seating facilities, one parking space for each six (6) seats;

(d) For places of assembly without fixed seating facilities,one parking space for each 200 square feet of area in such use;

(e) For retail sales of building materials, and goods
requiring extensive display areas, one parking space for each
800 square feet of area in such use;

(f) For other commercial or industrial buildings, at least one square foot of customer parking space be provided for one square foot of gross floor area."
