AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE OPERATION OF THE EXECUTIVE, JUDICIAL, AND LEGISLATIVE BRANCHES OF THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1968, FOR THE OPERATION OF THE OFFICE OF WASHINGTON REPRESENTATIVE FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1968, TO ADD SECTION 6113 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATING TO EMERGENCY EXPENSES, TO AUTHORIZE PAY INCREASES BY THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL, TO REPEAL PUBLIC LAWS 9-71, 9-97, 9-168 AND 9-193, MINTH GUAM LEGISLATURE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:
