AT ACT TO REFEAD CHAPTER 2 OF TITLE IX
OF THE COVERWEAT CODE OF GUAM TO RESTOKE JURISDICTION OF THE ISLAND COURT
OF GUAM AND THE DISTRICT COURT OF GUAM
OVER OFFENSES COLETTED IN GUAM BY
MELSEES OF THE ARLED FORCES OF THE UNITED
STATES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PROPER OF THE TENERMORY OF QUAM:

Section 1. Chapter 2 of Title IX of the Government Code of Guar, consisting of Sections 8100 and 8101, is hereby repealed in its entirety, and from and after the effective date of this Act all members of the Armed Forces of the United States in Guam shall be subject to trial in the Courts of Guam having jurisdiction over offenses charged against such members.

Section 2. This Act shall take effect September 1, 1968. Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.

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
