
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT TO REPEAL CHAPTER 2 OF TITLE IX
OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO RE-
STORE JURISDICTION OF THE ISLAND COURT
OF GUAM AND THE DISTRICT COURT OF GUAM
OVER OFFENSES COMMITTED IN GUAM BY
MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED
STATES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Chapter 2 of Title IX of the Government Code
3 of Guam, consisting of Sections 8100 and 8101, is hereby repealed
4 in its entirety, and from and after the effective date of this Act
5 all members of the Armed Forces of the United States in Guam shall
6 be subject to trial in the Courts of Guam having jurisdiction over
7 offenses charged against such members.

8 Section 2. This Act shall take effect September 1, 1968.

9 Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
