AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 11012 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAR TO RENAME THE DEDEDO ELEMENTARY SCHOOL THE "MARIA A. ULLOA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 11012 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 11012. Maria A. Ulloa Elementary School. The elementary school heretofore known as the Dededo Elementary School is hereby renamed the 'Maria A. Ulloa Elementary School' to honor the late school teacher from Dededo who served so capably in the public school system of Guam for a period of over half a century. At such ceremony as the Director deems appropriate, said school shall be so officially named at which time a plaque bearing the name, picture, and a brief history of Maria A. Ulloa shall be affixed at a suitable spot within the school."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
